The Northern Riders Christmas in July social was held at the Greyhound Club on Sunday 24 July. Most dancers dressed in their Christmas finery and it all looked

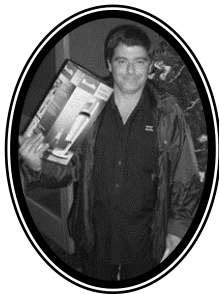
